INSTRUCTIONS ON REQUIREMENTS TO
SCHEDULE A CANCER CONSULTATION

Things Needed For All Consultations with Cancer Doctor

Any patient concerned family member and/or health care worker may make appointments for a patient with or concerned about cancer, to be seen at this clinic or any HBL/NCC Office.

Clinical Scope for Patients – age 15 years and above

- 1) Breast Cancer, Prostate Cancer – most common reasons for consultation
- 2) All advanced cancers, Unknown Cancer or Cancer of Unknown origin
- 3) Liver/Pancreas Cancer, Lung Cancer, Colon/Rectal/Anal Cancer
- 4) Cervical/Ovarian/Endometrial Cancer
- 5) Lymphoma – Hodgkin’s /Non-Hodgkin’s
- 6) Blood Cancer or Leukemia – Acute and Chronic
- 7) **Other cancers and/or diagnosis not specified here**

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY- bring any and all documentations you have.

- a) Pathological report: **Mandatory** for all patients with a prior diagnosis
- b) All operation reports and clinical notes, including biopsies
- c) All previous doctors’ notes – please confirm that photocopies are provided by the patient
- d) Contact information of last doctor that took care of this patient (name, cell phone number and physical address)
- e) All prior blood tests, (if available)
- f) All X-rays with or without reports, (if available)
- g) **Chest X-ray (PA and Lateral views) – all patient need to come with this!**
- h) **Full blood count, ferritin, liver function tests, electrolytes and creatinine - all**
- i) **Abdominal ultrasound – with or without written reports, (applicable to all)**
- j) All CAT scans, MRI with or without reports, (if available)
- k) Please bring any other documentation that may help your clinic visit, in your opinion
- l) **All current medications** (if available) – put all in a bag and bring to the appointment.
- m) New patient information form/medical consent form (to provide services provider and patient obligation)–pick up at time of registration, may also be filled on day of visit.
- n) **Home visits may also be arranged as needed.**

All patients are asked to please be punctual and plan to arrive at least 60 minutes before scheduled time to see the doctor. This will be to allow for time to complete paperwork and review of medical information by the nursing/support staff working with the on-duty cancer specialist at the Nwaneri Cancer Clinic.

All patients must bring a valid government-issued identification – an international passport from any country/a valid drivers license from any country/National ID card from any country. This is only used to verify your correct demographic data: name, age and sex
